And in the post-independence period, there have been several attempts to institutionalize them. This volume traces the history of rural local governments from the colonial period up to the present day. The first publication in this series by the Institute was titled "Status of Panchayati Raj in the States of India, 1994" which recounted the story up to the adoption of the 73rd Constitution Amendment. The second in the series was "Status of Panchayati Raj in the States and Union Territories of India, 2000" which continued detailed analysis of the working of panchayats at state, district and block levels.
